CHAPTER ONE

PROLOGUE

CHAPTER TWO
INTRODUCTION TO
AGENCY

By now I have decided that I am in quite a quandary. I cannot say that I am the Apostle of Allah without receiving scorn. I cannot say I am the not Apostle of Allah without lying. So I pondered exactly what has made me a prophet. My practices have been love, truth, and worship.

I believe that there is no time machine so I submit to the unusual situation that has been presented to me. Had I not declared blasphemy I would not have been truthful. This is the great contradiction of Judgment

Day and Allah taking a partner in Her Kingdom.

They say I am the pitiful one because I am motivated by the fear of evil and the edicts of God, instead of the passion for goodness and free will.

Regarding determinism there are some things less practical than others. Essentially we are dealing with three facets of agency. There is the will of self, the will of God, and the rules of matter. Matter achieves the maze of confusion. Only persistence

can achieve submission to God. The will of self navigates the disguised consciousness. This three-fold reduction of agency will never overrule the Mysterious Other and Her power, or the perfect manifestation of Her victory.

Perceiving free will does not make it unreal. It is only an abomination when we deny true guidance in favor of coincidence or regularity. This psychological defect runs so deep in our behavior training that nothing can

overcome it besides grace or intelligence. But grace can be so easily denied only to never be given again. Furthermore, in the case of intelligence, our greater mind is buried within. Only ambition separate from the worldly affairs can cause its origination.

There was a time in my prophetic lore that I was offered to be known as a deity, or to be known as a devil. In honesty, I prayed to Allah that there would never be and could never be a

deity associated with Her. I resigned myself to the fact that it would be better to be cursed on the Day of Doom than to seek to be a compeer of Allah. It turned trivial when God told me that I actually was Her Angel. By assuming it was better to be cursed by men than cursed by God, I achieved another goal. There was no reward, but I maintained my favorable status.

This led to a greater faith. No matter what anyone tells me about myself or my God, there is

a great fault of Christianity today. That is to make Allah the evil (or false) god, and to make Muhammad the evil (or false) prophet. Besides, they are all worshipping David while Solomon is worshipping Allah. These Christians will not receive what they seek, except for some who are anonymous Muslims. They have not realized themselves as such because of the calamity. Here we encounter another mystery of time and space.

Reincarnation is real. The peoples of the earth have been gathered to witness the polarity, the exaltation, and the humiliation. I have wondered why Muslims have been praying for 1400 years to spare Muhammad from humiliation on the Day of Judgment. They have received the inverse.

This led to my suspicion about exaltation and humiliation. Allah does not stone Her creatures. The absence of Her love and the eternal rejection from Her is

sufficient for their punishment. Many of them have been successful prior to God's reckoning. This differs from the case of prophets and believers who suffer only to later receive an eternity of Her love.

The meek shall inherit the earth. What a copout! Luck is not on my side. Her majesty provides sufficient promise of success. There was might before incompetence. Then a return to normalcy provided sufficient reason for gratitude.

There cannot be gratitude without reflection and acknowledgment. Then it is time to enumerate with humility. In such, there is no such thing as thanks without sincerity.

CHAPTER THREE

MORALITY

Redundancy can be commonplace in associating with Allah. Simple psychology suggests that worship with singleness of purpose sustains love. The necessity of obligations and the strictness of covenants are real. This is why folks are obligated to take notice of the Creator and indulge in a personal relationship.

Some say that to sin is to commit what you believe is sin. It follows naturally that devotion is

what you perceive is devotional.
Not so? Let's examine the
situation fully.

We must follow what has been revealed to us. Otherwise, we are donkeys in anarchy. Anarchy of souls has no justification. This is why Islam created the perfect society. The religion of truth is without fail when taken with proper interpretation. This is more than a token. Nothing suggests that the will of Allah could ever pass away. In any event, we need

collective morals as social animals. This is the first solution to anarchy.

Then there is the person. How well founded is her belief system? Is it even comparable to the perfect abstract of morality? Thus we have another obvious duality. We have the personal morality and the separate abstract. The abstract cannot ever be completely known. Therefore we receive good leniency in our personal beliefs.

Still one's personal beliefs can be so unreasonable that they receive no credit whatsoever from Allah. The obvious exemplars are the worshippers of Satan. The other obvious exemplars are nihilists. Be careful with agnosticism. It sometimes is not handled with perfect reason. Still, perfect reason is incomplete without intuition. Agnosticism without rigorous reason and sharp intuition inevitably fails to enlighten. The regrettable path of agnosticism is losing interest. This

is the great defeat of the false contentment.

A polytheist will not enter the pearly gates. This is why India will be ashamed. Suppose these gods actually existed. Every single one of them combined, including Shiva and Vishnu who are both omnipotent, could make an attack on Allah. Allah would defeat every single one of them all at once without moving a finger nail. This should be a lesson to not call upon Jesus, or Mary, or Michael

in any situation that is prayerful. Notice the rigorous majesty of Allah. Even if Michael were to assist you greatly without your knowledge it would have no power except with Allah as both actor and observer. It could all be a great charade if Allah decided to do something different. This is the power and impotence of the angels. There is no god besides Allah.

CHAPTER FOUR

CONSTANCY

When you feel constancy in your venture, you will come to realize that your path and your destiny are the same. Can we really accept this paradox of time and its creation? Nothing suggests that tomorrow is different from today besides what we literally experience, and the personal evolution of thought, emotion, and body.

Live for the moment and you will forget the next. Live for the next and you will forget the

moment. Constancy is therefore defined as one of the great struggles of transcendence. The Buddha described nirvana as not suffering, being without thought, and celebrating the feeling of emptiness. Emptiness in this case is not being without sentiency. It is purity of mind and spirit. The body then becomes immaterial.

Therefore singleness of purpose can be assimilated. If constancy is met, there is the anticipation of newness, the

instant gratification of simple existence, and the mastery to regard past sufferings without grievance. When God is real, repentance is necessary for the cleansing of sin. This makes peace with self to be necessary for constancy. But just as false prophets lead followers astray, non-acknowledgement of prior sin and failure to immediately supplicate is an error of personal judgment. Proclaim the good news. It is the simple enlightenment that God lives. For

the non-believer, these moments are brief and disregarded. When they become a craving, God calls the person with greater fervor and more frequency.

When one is certain that God lives, there is only one sin that is greater than prior rejection. It is forgetting. Losing al-Islam becomes worse than failure to convert. This happens when a person knows that God lives, but does not take notice of the parallel sensibility. Freedom besides recklessness completes

the path of truth and happiness.
Time then is no longer linear.
Neither is it circular except for
cases of unsound mind. This can
be a prison of finite recurrence.
The truth is that life is supposed to
become a gentle whirlwind.

Then to disobey becomes the
problem. It is unfortunate that the
grace period for these problems
has limitations. The failure to
achieve constancy with God as
Person reverts a human being to
the temporal circle and a return to
base desires. Sin becomes bliss

and ignorance becomes
happiness. God gives freely,
martyrs with justification, and
resurrects the sacred ones. To
each person belong burdens and
blessings.

CHAPTER FIVE

RECURRENCE

The next step in the path is to identify philosophy (to respect wisdom). Soon we will identify spirituality (to promote fruition), and behavior (to practice a discipline).

If one can identify one's life with certainty of joy and meaning there is a test. This is the eternal recurrence test. Eternal recurrence is a theory, not a reality. To evaluate self-worth remove God for a moment. God

will provide a satisfactory conclusion.

Take your existence to begin with birth and to end with death. Without predicting the future, now assume that upon your death that you will immediately revert to your original birth. It will now repeat exactly as is forever.

If such a thing were to happen, make a choice whether you would prefer to exist, or to not exist. If you would rather to have never

existed you have failed the test. If you have failed the test you are not considered to be truly happy. You might then grab senses and perception unstably; unreflective of your unconscious will. This will make you aloof of the preferred destiny, the one that is not different from your path.

This is an analysis of acceptance and being without resentment. Being without resentment will promote vigor for happiness. Then the equilibrium

of the heart center will not suffer defeat in any circumstance. Failure will add to success always.

Even though the beginning is now human birth, the lack of an ending can now be enigmatic. Continue the analysis now even though it will become self-serving.

If the circle will not end, it is time to notice free will. Under these circumstances the brain is the only salvation. Moreover, the

possibilities are endless because life never actually began. This is different from time linear theosophy because a resting place with God adds newness, never repetition.

But in this philosophical analysis, there is a prison of flesh and circumstance. Throw it away completely now for a release from prison. Because life does not exist outside of your brain, all other people are not real. Even if they were real, you are not really interacting with “them,” but rather

you have unusual meetings while they also exist inside their own heads.

So when you meet your friend from your distant past, you don't meet them with regard to parallel lives. You meet only a visage of them on your imaginary quest through the dimensions. This fantasy friend is unchanged in essence but entirely imaginary in manifestation. Perceiving this, there is no such thing as time but only navigation through a mystery.

Then even happy recurrence is upsetting and it is time to accept that your brothers and sisters are as real as you are, so do not harm them. If life is not imaginary, you must seek meaning. If you want greater meaning, take notice of the Greater God. Make it incumbent upon yourself to love always and remember that God is the most lovable in addition to being the most loving. Cherish this moment and the next because you will never go back to the last. Moreover, a life wasted

can be without waste by means of
a single revelation. God lives. She
is somewhere. You will find Her.

CHAPTER SIX
THE SELFISH IDENTITY

The ego is known simultaneously to be the selfish-identity and necessary identity. Thus there is a three-fold goal for us to attain as individuals. One must love God, others, and self with unity. To love God can be briefly described as to dedicate oneself entirely to Her with vicious persistence to not reject Her. To love others can be succinctly stated as to observe sentiency of others, with honest recognition that their being is not better or

CHAPER SEVEN

AMBITION

The first great goal is to know God. Following contact with the Other, the next mission is to love Her. Then it is time to do something about it. Without this submission of faith, love, and purpose there can never be good fortune. Failure to realize greater purpose may or may not result in worldly success. In either event, losing one's soul will be the great misfortune. Abandon jealousy and accept a lease of your soul. All souls belong to Allah.

As one progresses through the dimensions of thought and experience, there is binding locale to circumstance. Nothing suggests that God will send an angel or any other being to perform your words and deeds. Then be inordinately fond of a bilateral relationship. Even if ninety-eight times out of a hundred there is no free will whatsoever, the freedoms you do have equate to the same weight as life was without determinism.

Bravely, one then must do the right thing, the next right thing, and so on. Because God has determined ninety-eight percent of your actions without your knowledge, ask Her for sense and strength to exercise your freedom properly. As fate may have it, you will never know what actions performed by you were out of your control, and what choices were entirely up to you.

Therefore silence your resentments and become steadfast. The great

misunderstanding of inaction is self-mockery. God adds success to those who strive, and She provides ease after hardship. This cessation of difficulty leads to another great challenge. Do not forget mission one or mission two. Faith and love cannot be forgotten in the pursuit of perfect destiny.

If faith and love were to be replaced by ambition, you might actually get everything you prayed for. In this case, your mastery of self-interest overrules your original objectives. Your prayers

then become without meaning and will turn on you as the great destruction. Your dream wife will become as ogress, your children will be as devils, and your livelihood will be your great depression.

Finding victory with certainty is faith, not hope. Finding victory with uncertainty is trust, not avoidance. To manifest oneself into a human of submission and substance is to become the best of created things.

CHAPTER EIGHT

EXONERATION

To be exonerated is to be free from blame. To be forgiven is to be pardoned. To repent is to turn from sin and resolve to reform one's life.

Neither the writer nor the reader can attain exoneration or forgiveness without repentance. It may not be attainable to remember and acknowledge every sin, but repentance of behavior, specific or general, is required.

Therefore, let us first imagine forgiveness. Is this from the Almighty God that doesn't really care about a person besides their confession, regardless of his or her faith? We should hope not. Then theosophy becomes philosophy, philosophy becomes

behavior, and behavior becomes a reflection of inner beauty. It is a shame that our society values physical beauty as royalty. The most honorable person is the one who is outright beautiful without regard to their visage. This is the great success that even the Apostle may never attain, but it is noteworthy. CHAPTER FOURTEEN

Purging the universe takes creatures to new places. Expanding our knowledge can lead to clear and certain truth.

When comfortable, a person can take their ventures confidently.

Then life beyond the fourth dimension leads one only to laughter wondering if there can there be anything else.

Successfully becoming from nothing into a living being was not our doing.

Successful charity is certain obedience and nothing else. Being obedient to God requires a lot of time and effort to even be possible. First one has to seek Her, find Her, know Her, and love

Her. After this terrible trial is complete, all else seems as if it were some great delusion. There is no returning to the delusion. There is only oblivion.

To create, God found it fit to use premeditation and deliberation. With certainty of knowledge we find that nothing is needed besides God. If one is deaf they might hear someday. If one is listening, the great problem is to leave the room. There is nothing like being outside a room listening to another's occurrences,

but there is nothing worse than being behind a locked door on a dismal night. The people who crash the party are those who are not welcome. Thank God that the Hereafter is forbidden for every devil that creeps, crawls, or speaks. Nothing can stop the abomination that causes desolation. It will kill without end until the world is so full with garbage that a new one will be necessary.

Maybe our collection is a great thing, but union with Allah surpasses the mysteries of others because there is nothing at all like unto Her. Exposes of celebrities and monarchs of the earth provided us with sufficient pleasure but without just purpose.

Just as news media creates a collage of what we prefer to acknowledge, individual cases of human happiness are hard to come by if not fleeting. This is why some practice yoga and also why the Apostle practices Islam. The Apostle has been given Islam, so listen to him.

Infidels do not fear their reckoning because it has not become manifest. Sometimes we are well pleased to have received freedom without humility, other times we are offered humiliation

without choice. So when the choice arises, do not believe everything you hear. Do not believe everything you practice. Believe what you want to believe. It cannot benefit a sinner, so there will be no injustice. There is only perfect peace, passion, and love.

Mistake God for love and one is without blame. Mistake human love as God and there could be severe consequences. If you do not hearken unto the Benevolent One, there is no unity. Petty unity can be achieved by any means,

usually unfavorable. Call God the light and one is mistaken. Lofty and exalted is Allah, holy in attributes. She has left us with one name. There is no deity besides Allah, so do not let the Quran deceive. It cannot. It has been left with perfect purity for the perfectly pious. Ignoble infidels and every being without light cannot unify this theory. Only successful defeat and a place in hell will be for those who do not abide. Every living thing will soon come to know. Only Her majesty

can find this rapture for you. Will you repent then before your moment passes? There are no mountains left to climb. There is only a bridge. It will wobble if you are not certain and it will break if you do not take action. It is only as wide as your virtue.

Virtue then is claiming might. Claiming might is not virtue. This is why A is not always A. Provide sufficient deliberation before interpretation. You might then see what you did not read. The master

of disguises is your soul. The one disguised from us is Allah. Because we have gone so far from Her, we sometimes forget our origin. There is nothing besides our existing and there is nothing that sustains our existence besides Her. Abandon your family and your wealth. Not so! Persist in the delusion that you need something other than what you have. Do not! Claim Her justice in your heart so there might be certainty. When all is irrelevant, then you are not

relevant. If every moment is a memento there is perfect justice.

Smile if you fear Allah, because She is worthy of all praise. Do not succumb to cowardice lest you cannot believe. Thus faith needs courage. Faith also needs maintenance. Practice perfection and you will not succeed. Practice nobility so that you might be honored. Only then will your monopoly on destiny pass away into something that is better.

Practice sincerity and you will know nobility better. Nobility cannot be insincere. What a plethora of honesty!

Congratulations, o sinner, your works have been accepted.

Masters rule their slaves in vain but Allah lords with perfect justice.

The master of masterpieces is better than your boss. She is your ruler. The Kingdom of Heaven has announced its perfection, its majesty, and its singleness of purpose. No longer will the peoples of the earth suffer by their

own warmongering. No Antichrist will be killed on the battlefield. That is because there is no Messiah and there is no Antichrist. There is only the Apostle. The One True Prophet is to be rejected or denied. He cannot wage war. Neither can he be defeated. Only the brave will succumb to his destiny; many will be ashamed by their bashful concurrence. Only Allah determines when a suffering man is relieved. The Apostle is not Satan the rejected one.

done.

Practicing patience over that
which seems to be eternal is
certain duty. Shame yourself if
you cannot wait for tomorrow

because today is none other than today. Today is definitely eternal, but it will also die; who then might be Immortal?

CHAPTER FIFTEEN

BEHAVIOR

The great mystery of philosophy is that the mystical is not separate from that which is practical. Any mystic can testify to this truth. The miracle is not that which is unseen but the everlasting benefits of submitting to the truth that is right.

Let the little known word that is theosophy become in accordance with philosophy. This is why satanic philosophers

without God become useless,
even a burden to anyone who
listens to them. This is why Ayn
Rand and Frederick Neitzche are
hellions who will never be saved.
Do not let them be your friends.

It is far better to be a steadfast
and simple person than to be an
exalted and outrageous person.
Still most desire exaltation, and
this always leads to the outrage of
others. Is it good then to be
envied? The Apostle is already
envied by every angel in heaven

and even the jinn who support him.

Love has not been lost for Allah in the heart of the true believer. But the Hereafter leads to outrage when an ignorant man finds his life that was so special to him was merely sport and pastime. It is called a sport because we have life threatening decisions at every waking moment regarding salvation, and the time of a human life is a single hour. The Hereafter is eternal, and the hour wasted will then be

outrageously abhorred by those who did not understand.

How then can one practice philosophy? The philosophy of discipline requires rules and structure. This is why personal covenants with God are as weighty as the general rules for any human being.
